This project is bilingual, French and English, and contributors in either or both languages are accepted. Submissions are published as they are submitted. All contributions must be sent by email to artisnaturacontact@gmail.com **between February 1st and May 31st 2018**. Please also include a short biography and profile picture along with the submission. Submissions must adhere to *Artis Natura*'s submission protocol. All accepted contributions for this issue will be compiled into a printed edition.
